KDOT construction projects affecting traffic

1. **Gold Project Phase 2A: North Junction** – I-135, I-235, K-96 & K-254

Construction began on April 5, 2021. Three-year project that replaces the I-135 ramps to SB I-235/WB K-96. Project website at www.135Gold.com.

- **On Tuesday the 21st, the NB I-235 Exit to NB I-135 will be closed, 9 am until 3 pm, for bridge work over the ramp. *NEW***
- **On Dec. 7, the WB K-254 Exit to SB I-135 CLOSED to construct the lane extension for this ramp onto SB I-135. The ramp is expected to open March 1, weather dependent. WB K-254 traffic can continue onto SB I-235 to Broadway to NB I-235 to SB I-135. *RAMP CLOSURE***
- A **13'9" height restriction** on SB I-135 under SB I-235 is in effect.
- An **11' width restriction** has been posted on WB K-254 to SB I-235.
- A long-term **11' width restriction** on the two lanes of SB I-135, 53rd St. to south of the I-235/K-254, is in effect (along with a 50-mph work zone speed limit).

2. **Gold Project Phase 2B: North Junction to I-135/K-96 Interchange**

Construction began Feb. 6 and impacts to traffic begin the week of Feb. 13. This phase includes a direct link from EB K-96 (from NB I-235) to EB K-96 at the junction on I-135, and new ramps for WB K-96 onto I-135.

- *The week of Feb. 27, barrier wall will be installed on the 29th St. Entrance Ramp onto SB I-135. **Coming Soon***
- *In early March, a long-term closure of SB I-135 Exit Ramp to 29th St. **Coming Soon***
- *In late March, a long-term closure of the Hydraulic Exit to EB K-96. **Coming Soon***

3. Repair of the WB U.S. 54 bridge at the K-251 junction (far western Sedgwick County), began on May 2, 2022 and has been **suspended for the winter**. Bridge painting and permanent pavement markings will be completed in the spring.
