KDOT maintenance projects affecting traffic

- Possible left lane closures this week, 9 am 3 pm, on I-135 from Kellogg to 17th St. for bridge drain cleaning.
- Possible closures of the right lane on SB I-135 at Pawnee on Wednesday and on NB I-135 at Pawnee on Thursday for electrical work on overhead lights.
- Bridge drain cleaning on US 54 is possible, weather permitting.

KDOT construction projects affecting traffic

1. Gold Project Phase 2A: North Junction – I-135, I-235, K-96 & K-254

Construction began on April 5, 2021. Three-year project that replaces the I-135 ramps to SB I-235/WB K-96. Project website at www.135Gold.com.

- The WB K-254 Exit to SB I-135 is OPEN.
- A long-term 11' width restriction on the two lanes of SB I-135, 53rd St. to south of the I-235/K-254, is in effect (along with a 50-mph work zone speed limit).

2. Gold Project Phase 2B: North Junction to I-135/K-96 Interchange

Construction began Feb. 6 and impacts to traffic began the week of Feb. 13. This phase includes a direct link from EB K-96 (from NB I-235) to EB K-96 at the junction on I-135, and new ramps for WB K-96 onto I-135.

- Likely in late-May or June, the SB I-135 Exit to EB K-96 will be closed on three days with little advance notice. A bridge over the UP railroad is to be replaced and half of the current bridge must be removed first. The UP RR is allowing a six-hour window for the work but they will not give much notice of the days the work can be done. NEW
- A long-term closure of the Hydraulic Exit to EB K-96 began on March 27 for the reconstruction of the EB K-96 bridge over the UP RR. Ramp Closed
- SB I-135 Exit to EB K-96 has an 11' width restriction. Started March 8, 2023. Long-term Width Restriction
- A long-term closure of SB I-135 Exit Ramp to 29th St. began on March 8.
 Ramp Closed
- **3.** An asphalt mill and overlay project on **K-254 from Hydraulic Ave. to the Butler County line began April 17.** Work began in the right lane on EB K-254 with asphalt milling then asphalt overlay the entire length of the project. Then the crew will work west on the WB lanes from the county line back to Hydraulic. Next, back to the east then the westbound lane. Permanent pavement markings will complete the project.
 - **Expect single lane traffic each weekday** until the project is finished. Traffic control will be removed each night.
- 4. Concrete pavement patching on I-235 from the South Junction with I-135 to N.
 Meridian began Sunday, April 23rd. Work hours will be Sundays 1 pm 6 am, Mondays Thursdays 7 pm 6 am. NEW PROJECT
 - Work will progress Monday through Thursday nights, 7 pm 6 am, with single lane traffic on SB I-235 as the contractor works toward the South Junction of I-235 and I-135. NEW
- **5.** Concrete pavement patching on **K-15 from just north of MacArthur Road to the Derby city limit** will begin Sunday, **May 14th at 1 pm**. Work hours will be Sundays 1 pm 6 am, Mondays Thursdays 7 pm 6 am. **NEW PROJECT in May**
