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## **Field survey is set for bridge improvements on northbound K-15 to I-135 ramp**

A field survey for proposed bridge improvements on northbound K-15 to the I-135 ramp in Wichita is expected to begin around Monday, March 4.


The proposed improvement would be on the bridge on northbound K-15 that connects to the I-135 ramp over Gypsum Creek. The length of the survey is about 2,000 feet and is based on the existing alignment.

The field survey, expected to be completed by May 31, will gather information needed for the detailed design of the proposed improvement.

A member of the survey crew will contact property owners and/or tenants for permission to enter private property. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine the locations of existing features within the survey corridor.
