Highway resurfacing projects near Garden City

The Kansas Department of Transportation expects the first of a series of resurfacing projects in the Garden City area to begin by Wednesday, July 17, weather permitting. The first project, on U.S. 83, begins at the south junction with old U.S. 83 and continues north to the concrete pavement south of Schulman Avenue, a distance of about eight miles.

During construction, traffic will be limited to one lane through the work zone, guided by a pilot car. Drivers can expect delays of 15 minutes or less. The Kansas DOT urges drivers to be alert, pay attention to all work zone warning signs, slow down when approaching a work zone and be prepared to stop. Oversized loads will be restricted to a maximum length of 80 feet and a maximum width of 18 feet.

APAC-Kansas, Inc., Shears Division is the primary contractor on this project at a cost of approximately \$1.4 million. KDOT expects work on this project to be completed by the end of August, depending on weather. Additional work runs from the junction of U.S. 83 and U.S. 83 business to the bridge carrying U.S. 83 business over the Arkansas River; and on K-156 from 750 feet east of Crestway Drive to Roman Road.
