

The Kansas Department of Transportation's ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM May 2011

OBJECTIVE: Create net new jobs and capital investment in the State by using transportation

investments to recruit new businesses and encourage growth of existing

businesses.

ANNUAL FUNDING: \$10 million in reimbursement grants

ELIGIBLE PROJECTS: Any transportation project that can be shown to support job growth or

capital investment in the State. All modes are eligible, including road projects on and off the state-system, rail projects, airport improvements and public transit investments. Typical projects include access roads, turning lanes, and rail spurs.

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS: Local Governments, often in partnership with a private business

LOCAL MATCH: A 25% minimum local match is generally required, although this is negotiable

REQUIREMENTS: Must address a transportation problem such as enhancing safety, improving

access or mobility, or relieving congestion

Must be non-speculative, meaning the program is not intended to fund

improvements merely for future recruitment of businesses

Other basic infrastructure must be in place or eminent, such as water and

other utilities

Projects cannot just transfer business from one part of the state to another

Must have the support of local leaders such as elected officials and the

chamber of commerce

APPROVAL PROCESS: If a project's approval is critical to recruit a new business to the State, a decision

will be made within 45 days. For projects that are not time-sensitive, projects will

be pooled and selected annually as funding is available
