Safe Driving Refresher: is a course offered to all businesses and organizations interested in improving the overall safety and manner in which employees travel. Designed with safe travel, good judgment and wise practice in mind, this 3 hour interactive presentation is heavy on audience participation and feedback. Participants will identify distractions and other common accident causes, watch traffic safety videos, and participate in activities that review information presented in most high school Driver's Education programs. At the conclusion of this course, students receive a completion certificate that can sometimes be sent to insurance agents for a discount in insurance rates.
