In general motorcycle industry standards 49cc is the cut off for 5 brake horse power.

Motorcycle

Every motor vehicle having a seat or saddle for the use of the rider and designed to travel on not more than three wheels in contact with the ground including, but not limited to, vehicles commonly known as pocket rockets, miniature motorcycles, miniature choppers and similar motorized vehicles, but excluding a tractor.
