## **I-435 Restriping Project in Johnson County Begins on Monday, April 28**

Weather permitting, on **Monday, April 28**, a restriping project on both northbound and southbound I-435 from K-32 to the I-35 interchange in Johnson County will begin. New pavement markings will be placed on all mainline lanes and adjoining entrance and exit ramps on I-435. Daily lane and ramp closures will occur on I-435 for the restriping work.

Crews will work daily Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and again from 6:30 p.m. to 6:30 a.m. Traffic will be guided through the project work zone via a slow moving vehicle operation. Drivers should expect minor delays. The entire project is scheduled to be completed by early summer 2008.
