### **K-32 Closures Scheduled for Railroad Crossing Repair Project in Wyandotte County**

Weather permitting, on **Monday, August 18**, K-32 just west of 121<sup>st</sup> Street in Bonner Springs will be reduced to one lane in each direction for a railroad crossing repair project. The K-32 lane reductions will be in place for approximately four days (two days each for westbound and eastbound work). Project work is scheduled to be completed on **Thursday, August 21**.
