US-69 (18th Street) Closure Scheduled for Bridge Repair in Wyandotte County

Beginning at **9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, November 12**, US-69 (18th Street) over the Kansas River Bridge will close again in Wyandotte County for repair work. US-69 traffic will not be allowed past Ruby Avenue on the south side of the bridge or past Kansas Avenue on the north side of the bridge. **The US-69 closures will begin at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, November 12, and will reopen to all traffic at 6:00 a.m. on Monday, November 24.**

Crews will repair the rocker and expansion joints on the bridge. This work is part of a series of closures for this bridge repair project. Additional news releases will be issued for the future work and related closures.

Advance message boards will alert drivers to the lane closures. Marked detours will be provided. **Northbound** 18th Street traffic will detour via I-35 southbound to I-635 northbound to Kansas Avenue eastbound to 18th Street. **Southbound** 18th Street will detour via Kansas Avenue westbound to I-635 southbound to I-35 northbound to 18th Street. Drivers should expect delays and are advised to use alternate routes, if possible. APAC-KANSAS, Inc. is the primary contractor on this bridge repair project with a total contract cost of \$2,677,402. **The scheduled completion date for the entire project is spring 2009.**

The Kansas Department of Transportation urges all motorists to be alert, obey the warning signs, and "Give 'Em a Brake!" when approaching and driving through the project work zone.
