KDOT to upgrade guardrail along U.S. 166 in Chautauqua County

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) expects on Tuesday, April 9, to begin a project to upgrade guardrail at four locations on U.S. 166 in Chautauqua County.

The upgrades will take place 2 miles east of Niotaze. Temporary signals will direct one-lane traffic through the work zone; expect brief delays. Weather permitting, the work should be finished by the end of September. KDOT awarded the construction contract of \$1.7 million to B&B Bridge Company LLC of St. Paul, Kansas.
