K-26 mill and overlay to start

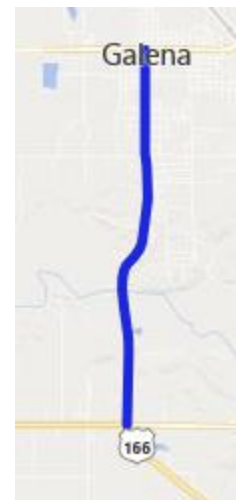
The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) expects to begin a mill and overlay project on K-26 this Friday, April 24, weather permitting.

The road work starts at the U.S. 166 junction and continues north to the K-66 junction at Galena.

A pilot car and flaggers will guide one-lane traffic through the work zone; expect delays of 15 minutes or less during daylight hours. The project should be finished in one week, weather permitting.

KDOT awarded the construction contract of \$460,747 to Bettis Asphalt & Construction, Inc., of Topeka.
