## Survey to begin for bridge improvements in McPherson County

Beginning Monday, Dec. 12, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) plans to begin a field survey to gather information necessary for bridge improvements in McPherson County.

The bridge is located on K-61, over Union Pacific Railroad, about .2 mile east of the K-153 spur and the bridge over U.S. 81.

The survey will take place on the existing highway alignment.

KDOT expects the survey to be completed by Feb. 15, 2023. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the corridor.

A member of the survey crew will contact property owners or tenants for permission to enter private property.
