U.S. 36/K-15 closed for resurfacing

The U.S. 36/K-15 junction in Washington County has been closed by the contractor as work progresses to resurface U.S. 36 within the Washington city limits in Washington County.

Motorists can follow a signed detour via K-9 and K-148. The junction of U.S. 36/K-15 is scheduled to reopen in September, weather permitting.

Smoky Hill LLC. of Salina is the prime contractor and has scheduled this \$4.2 million project to be completed by the summer of 2023.
