Bridge repair underway in Geary County

Work has begun for bridge repair on K-57 in Geary County. The bridge is located about three miles southeast of I-70 over Clarks Creek on K-57 highway.

Traffic signals will direct one lane of traffic through construction at a reduced speed. Motorists should allow for extra time in their travel schedules.

Wildcat Construction Co. Inc. of Wichita is the prime contractor for this \$263,616 project and has scheduled work to be completed in December, weather permitting.
