U.S. 36 crack seal to begin today

Beginning today, April 11, the Kansas Department of Transportation will begin crack seal projects on U.S. 36 in Republic and Washington counties.

Work on U.S. 36 will begin at the east city limits of Belleville and continue east about 18 miles to about 4 miles east of the Republic/Washington County line.

Flaggers and a pilot car will direct one lane of traffic through construction. Drivers should be prepared for a delay of up to 15 minutes and plan extra time in their travel schedules.

Pavement Pros of McPherson is the prime contractor and have scheduled these projects to be completed by May, weather permitting, at a total cost of \$150,490.50.
