KDOT requesting comments on draft 2019 STIP

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) requests comments on the draft Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2019-2022 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) document.

The STIP is a project specific publication that lists all KDOT administered projects, regardless of funding source, and includes projects for counties and cities as well as projects on the State Highway System. The draft STIP document is available for review online at <http://www.ksdot.org/bureaus/burProgProjMgmt/stip/stip.asp> Select the draft FFY 2019-2022 STIP link at the top of the page.
