## KDOT, Department of Agriculture to celebrate deployment of innovative technologies along U.S. 83

Kansas Transportation Secretary Julie Lorenz and Agriculture Secretary Mike Beam will visit McCarty Family Farms near Rexford to bring attention to the Great Plains Rural Freight Technology Corridor project on a 100-mile stretch of U.S. 83. This project will improve safety and economic productivity on a key freight transport route in western Kansas.
