U. S. 54 Pavement Repairs through Goddard

Set to Begin

Two Kansas Department of Transportation highway projects on U.S. 54 in the Goodard area will begin in early June.

Beginning Sunday night, June 2, a project to seal joints and cracks on U.S. 54 from K-163 (Garden Plain) to 119th Street West will close one lane of traffic – starting with one of the eastbound lanes of U.S. 54 – in the evening and overnight hours. The work will take place on Sunday – Thursday nights from 6 p.m. until 6 a.m. with lane closures for 3 ½ miles. All lanes will be open on this project during the day.

Huff Sealing Company of Albion, Illinois is the contractor on the \$458,343.91 project.

A second project will begin Monday, June 3 with daytime work on U.S. 54 from 215th Street West to 183rd Street West. This work will include concrete patching and on the eastbound lanes, concrete patching and an asphalt overlay. A single lane closure, starting with the westbound lanes, will be made and remain closed during concrete cure time.

Bryant & Bryant of Halstead is the contractor on this \$463,075.20 project.

Both projects should be completed by the end of July. They are part of the highway preservation component of T-WORKS, an \$8 billion, 10-year transportation approved by the 2010 Kansas Legislature.
