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Chip and seal project on K-31 may begin Sept. 13

A chip and seal project may begin Friday, Sept. 13 on K-31 in Osage County, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation.

The project extends from the west at mile marker 10.09, the Lyon/Osage County line going east to mile marker 16.0 at the K-31/Dacotah Street intersection in Burlingame. This is a two-day project, weather permitting.

The contractor anticipates starting the project on Friday, Sept. 13 with completion on Saturday, Sept. 14. However, if the project does not start this weekend it will begin on Monday, Sept. 16 and the contractor anticipates completion on Tuesday, Sept. 17, weather permitting.

One-lane traffic will be controlled by a pilot car. Motorists should expect delays of up to 15 minutes and should add extra time to their travel schedules.

Vance Brothers Inc. of Kansas City, Mo., is the contractor on the \$123,000 project.
