# I-35 bridge lengthening project in Olathe to close for the winter, closures this weekend

The Kansas Department of Transportation will be wrapping up operations for the winter season on the I-35 bridge lengthening project near 151<sup>st</sup> Street in Olathe. Work has been completed on the northbound bridge. Work to lengthen the southbound bridge will resume in the spring from approximately March to June of 2020. Exact dates and details to be announced at a later date.

Lane closures will take place this weekend in order to normalize the traffic pattern in this area.


#### Friday, Nov. 15
