### K-18 at Miller Parkway

**RAMP CLOSURES:** Westbound Miller Parkway ramps at K-18 will be CLOSED for concrete work on **Friday, June 14 between 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.** This closure is needed for the pouring of concrete for the north abutment of the bridge carrying Miller Parkway traffic over K-18.

The Kansas Department of Transportation urges all motorists to be alert, obey the warning signs, and "Give 'Em a Brake!" when approaching and driving through the project work zone.

These closures are for construction work on the overall improvement project that will reconstruct a seven-mile stretch of K-18 from Manhattan to Ogden to a freeway when completed. There are three construction phases included in the overall K-18 improvement project.
