I-70 repairs in Wabaunsee County start June 20

Eastbound I-70 in Wabaunsee County from mileposts 321 to 322.5 will be reduced to one lane beginning Tuesday, June 20, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation.

The lane reduction is necessary for concrete patching. There will be no speed limit reduction, but motorists are asked to use extra caution in the work zone.
