Repair work on K-63 north of St. Marys will delay traffic

The Kansas Department of Transportation will close southbound K-63 approximately six miles north of St. Marys on Wednesday, May 3. The closure will be in effect for about three weeks.

Traffic on K-63 in this area will be reduced to one lane and controlled by traffic signals. Please allow extra time to travel through the construction area.

The closure in Pottawatomie County is necessary to allow for the replacement of a collapsed wing-wall of a culvert on the west side of the highway as well as replacing part of the shoulder. KDOT maintenance staff will make the repairs.
