## U.S. 36 railroad crossing to close this weekend for repairs

Union Pacific Railroad will close and replace its crossing on U.S. 36 near Baileyville in Nemaha County this weekend. Work will begin at 7 a.m. on Friday, Aug. 12, and is expected to be complete by 7 p.m. on Saturday, Aug. 13.

The roadway will be closed to all traffic at the railroad crossing. Motorists can follow the signed detour using K-99, K-9 and K-63.
