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U.S. 59/K-4 mill and overlay project to begin March 28 in Jefferson County

According to the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT), a mill and overlay project on U.S. 59/K-4 from 206th St. to K-16 in Jefferson County is scheduled to begin on Monday, March 28, weather permitting.

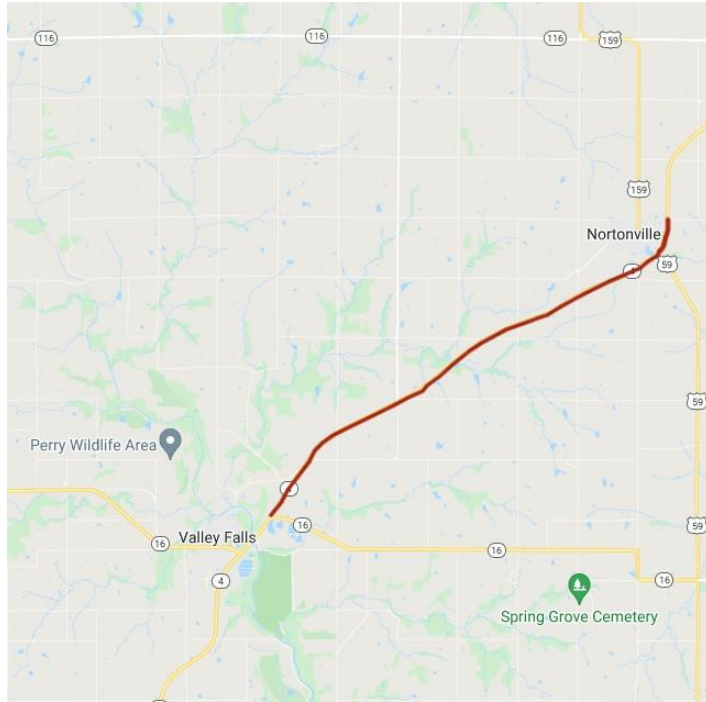
Traffic will be restricted to one lane and directed by a pilot car, flaggers, signs and cones. Portable message boards are in place in the area in advance of the project. Drivers should plan for delays of up to 15 minutes and add extra time in their travel schedules.

Work will occur Monday to Friday, and Saturday as needed, from 6:30 a.m. to 7 p.m. The project is expected to be completed in late July.

Herzog Contracting Corporation of St. Joseph, Mo., is the contractor for the \$4.8 million project.
