DOUGLAS COUNTY (K-10)

Daily Closures (Weather Permitting) (These closures will go up and come down all in one day, usually rush hour to rush hour)

Maintenance

-No maintenance related traffic control occurring at this time

Road Construction

-No short term work occurring at this time

Long-Term Closures (Weather Permitting)(These closures are longer in duration and will be in place continuously)

SHAWNEE COUNTY (Urban sections of I-70, I-470, US-24 and US-75)

Daily Closures (Weather Permitting) (These closures will go up and come down all in one day, usually rush hour to rush hour)

Maintenance

- No maintenance related traffic control occurring at this time

Road Construction

Update: Crews will be overlaying the Delaware bridge just east of Perry. Approximate RP 383. We will reduce US-24 to one travel lane and flag traffic through the work zone. We will begin with the east bound lane and flag traffic through the west bound. When finished with the east bound side we will flip traffic and overlay the west bound side.

Long-Term Closures (Weather Permitting)(These closures are longer in duration and will be in place continuously)

The Northbound & Southbound (outside) driving lanes of US-75 are closed between 1500 feet south of 46th street bridge and 1500 feet north of 46th street bridge for bridge patching work. Traffic control will consist of lane closures and reduced speed to 55 mph in the work zone. The work will be occurring from 6:30 am through 8 pm Monday through Saturday for the next 4 weeks, lane closures will remain throughout the night time hours.

Starting Monday, 8/27/18, the NB lanes of I-70 will be closed to one lane traffic between 46th Street to 94th street for roadway patching work. Traffic control will consist of lane closures and reduced speed to 55 mph in the work zone. The work will be occurring from 6:30 am through 8 pm, Monday through Friday for the next 4 weeks, lane closures will remain throughout the night time hours.
