For Tuesday/Saturday, July 27-31 in Topeka/Shawnee County

I-470

Westbound I-470 was reduced to one lane beginning on Wednesday, July 21 at 6:00 p.m., on a 2-mile stretch from Gage Boulevard to 21st Street for concrete pavement repair work. Work will take place daily, Monday through Saturday between 6:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.; no work will take place on Sunday. Adjacent I-470 interchange ramps will close for pavement repair work. All project work is scheduled to be completed by October 2010. The current ramp closures scheduled are as follows:

Gage Boulevard to westbound I-470 entrance ramp will close for pavement repair work between 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, July 27 and 6:00 a.m. on Wednesday, July 28, and again from 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 28 and 6:00 a.m. on Thursday, July 29. No marked detours will be provided. Project work is scheduled to be completed on Thursday, July 29.

Westbound I-470 to Fairlawn Road exit ramp will close for pavement repair work between 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 29 and 6:00 a.m. on Friday, July 30, and again between 6:00 p.m. on Friday, July 30 and 6:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 31. No marked detours will be provided. Project work is scheduled to be completed on Saturday, July 31.
