

In an effort to save money KDOT will consider the following for HMA projects in calendar years 2015-2016.

- 1) The following HMA projects let in FY15 prior to Feb. 2015 that **cannot** be held over for construction to calendar year 2016.

- 2) Contractors may request that the starting dates of a couple of projects be delayed in order to maintain a work force during the slowdown of HMA projects scheduled for letting. Those requests should come to my attention by e-mail or US Mail and also copy the District office where the project(s) is located. A determination will be made on a state-wide basis the acceptability of those requests.
- 3) KDOT agreed to allow an increased amount of RAP with a few requirements-
 - a. On jobs that are straight overlays or overlays over PCCP and no RAP source we allow up to 15% permissive RAP. Depending on the District there currently is little inspection of these RAP piles. We are open to allowing up to 25% RAP if we know and approve the source of the RAP or if we go and sample the RAP and grade it.
 - b. On mill and overlay type jobs we allow 25% max. RAP. We have a trial project set up with rejuvenators that would allow the increase to be 40% with some additional up front testing. We are open to allowing this on more projects.
 - c. Blending Chart jobs – no change needed here.
 - d. On the RAS and RAP option we will still need to cap this at 5% RAS and 10% RAP.
 - e. For shoulder mixes we are open to allowing more RAP if it is set at 15% max.
- 4) Proposals for increasing RAP will need to be e-mailed or US- Mail to my attention with a copy to the District office where the project is located. The dollar savings must be included with computations and how you are proposing to split those savings. A 50-50 split will not be entertained. The whole point of allowing this is to save money so more projects can be let. We are not willing to sacrifice quality or longevity in order to save a few dollars.
- 5) Other Innovative or cost saving proposals will be looked at as they are submitted. Again the dollar savings must be detailed along with the proposed split of the savings.

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
