## I-35 & I-435 Interchange

**EXPECT DELAYS! WEEKDAY/OVERNIGHT LANE & RAMP CLOSURES:** The I-35 and I-435 interchange area will have varying lane and ramp closures for the **week of Wednesday-Sunday, June 4-8** for preparation work including pavement marking and bridge deck removal for the upcoming widening of the eastbound I-435 bridge over I-35. The schedule for the lane and ramp closures is as follows. **Project work is scheduled to be completed on Sunday, June 8, weather permitting.**

Eastbound I-435 left lane at I-35 CLOSED

Eastbound I-435 left two lanes at I-35 CLOSED



**Thursday, June 5**

1:00 am-4:00 am

Southbound I-35 to eastbound I-435 ramp CLOSED

8:00 pm-10:00 pm

Northbound & southbound I-35 left lanes at I-435 CLOSED

10:00 pm-5:00 am, Friday, June 6

Southbound I-35 left two lanes at I-435 CLOSED



**Friday, June 6**

10:00 pm-5:00 am, Saturday, June 7

Northbound I-35 to westbound I-435 ramp CLOSED

Northbound I-35 right lane at I-435 CLOSED



**Saturday, June 7**

10:00 pm-5:00 am, Sunday, June 8

Southbound I-35 to eastbound I-435 ramp CLOSED

Southbound I-35 right lane at I-435 CLOSED

No marked detours will be provided. I-35 traffic will detour via the next available interchange exit to turnaround and take I-35 the opposite direction to access I-435. Traffic will be directed through the project work zone via signage and cones. Drivers should expect some delays through the project work zone during the lane and ramp closures.
