



Flooded Road Closures for NORTHEAST KANSAS
As of Monday, June 27, 2011, 10:00 p.m.

K-7 in Doniphan County is STILL CLOSED from the City of Sparks to the Nebraska/Kansas state line due to high waters from the Missouri River on the roadway. The roadway is expected to be closed for several more days due to continued melting snow from the northern states that are contributing to high river levels. K-7 originally closed to all traffic on Tuesday, May 31, 2011 at 8:15 a.m.

NEW!! US-59 in Atchison County (Kansas) is NOW CLOSED over the Amelia Earhart Bridge to the junction of US-45 in Buchanan County, Missouri due to flooding on the Missouri side of US-59, as of 9:45 p.m. on Monday, June 27. Drivers still can travel south on US-45 in Missouri, but access to the Amelia Earhart Bridge is closed to all thru traffic. The only other river crossings available until further notice are at US-36 in St. Joseph, MO, and the Centennial Bridge/K-92 in Leavenworth, KS.

Drivers must use alternate routes. No marked detours provided. Drivers: Do not attempt to drive through flooded or high water on roadways. **TURN AROUND. DON'T DROWN!**

We will let you know when the roadway reopens to all traffic.
