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Pavement Striping Work Begins on US-69, I-70, and I-670 in Wyandotte County

Weather permitting, on **Monday, September 17**, a project to remove and repaint pavement striping on US-69, I-70, and I-670 in Wyandotte County will begin. The pavement striping work will take place on US-69/18th Street from I-35 to I-70, and on I-70 and I-670 from the I-70/I-670 split to the Missouri state line. Project work will take place Monday through Saturday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., and again from 6:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. The roadway will be open to all traffic during peak hours each day from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m., and again from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Traffic will experience varying lane/ramp closures throughout the duration of the project. Traffic will be guided via signage. The latest updated daily lane/ramp closure information for this pavement striping project can be viewed online at: www.ksdot.org/kcmetro/laneclose.asp. Drivers should expect some minor delays and are encouraged to use alternate routes, if possible.

Highway Technologies Inc. is the primary contractor for this pavement striping project with a total contract cost of \$178,490. The striping project should be completed within seven calendar days.

The Kansas Department of Transportation urges all motorists to be alert, obey the warning signs, and “Give ‘Em a Brake!” when approaching and driving through work zones.
