US-69

EXPECT DELAYS! All northbound and southbound lanes will be closed from the 167th Street interchange to the 151st Street interchange for demolition work by the City of Overland Park on the 159th Street Bridge beginning **at 7:00 p.m. on Saturday, January 7 and reopening to all traffic at 10:00 a.m. on Sunday, January 8.** Also, all eastbound and westbound lanes of 159th Street over US-69 will be closed during this same timeframe.

Advance message boards will alert drivers to the roadway closures. Marked detours will be provided. Drivers should expect delays and must use alternate routes during the roadway closures.

Project work is scheduled to be completed on Sunday morning, January 8, weather permitting.
