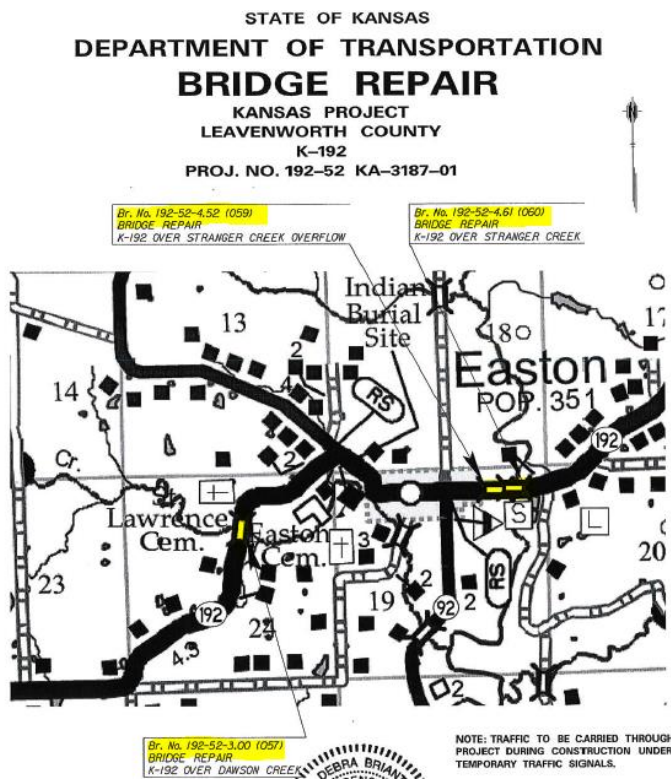

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K-192 Multi-Bridge Repair Project Begins in Leavenworth County

On **Monday, July 28**, a resurfacing and repair project began on the K-192 bridges over Dawson Creek, Stranger Creek and Stranger Creek outflow channel near Easton (Leavenworth County). Project work includes deck patching, overlay work and abutment repair work on the three bridges. Work will take place during daylight hours,

Monday through Friday, with some occasional Saturday work.

On **Monday, July 28**, eastbound and westbound K-192 over all three bridges was reduced to one open lane for both directions, 24/7 round the clock, throughout the project duration. Traffic will be directed via temporary traffic signals (located at either end of each bridge), concrete barrier, signs and cones through the project work zone. Drivers should expect some delays during peak commute times and may wish to use alternate routes, if possible. There will be a posted speed limit of 30 mph and an 11-foot lane width restriction through the project work zone at all times.

The Kansas Department of Transportation urges all motorists to be alert, obey the warning signs, and “Give ‘Em a Brake!” when approaching and driving through the project work zone.

PCI Roads, LLC (St. Michael, MN) is the primary contractor on this bridge repair project with a total contract cost of \$1.444 million. **The scheduled completion date for the entire project is late November 2014, weather permitting.**
