I-35 night work to affect traffic on June 22

A lane reduction and short closure is scheduled on a stretch of I-35 on June 22 to replace message boards over the roadways, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation.

Northbound and southbound I-35 just south of the Southwest Boulevard interchange will have one lane reduced at 8 p.m. on June 22. The southbound Southwest Boulevard ramp will be closed at 9 p.m. A second lane of I-35 will be reduced at 11 p.m. At midnight, southbound I-35 will be fully closed to traffic for five minutes to replace the message board. The ramp will be re-opened after this, and I-35 will be open to normal traffic by 5 a.m.
