I-35 night work to affect traffic on June 12

A lane reduction and temporary shutdown are scheduled for northbound I-35 just north of the 18th Street Expressway the evening of June 12, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation. This is necessary to reset the message board over the roadways.

Northbound I-35 just north of the 18th Street Expressway interchange will have one lane reduced at 8 p.m. A second lane of I-35 will be reduced at 11 p.m. and the northbound 18th Street Expressway on-ramp will be closed. At midnight, northbound I-35 will be fully closed to traffic for five minutes to reset the message board. I-35 will be open to normal traffic by 5 a.m.
