I-35 night work to affect traffic on May 17-18

Lane reductions are scheduled for two different sections of I-35 on Wednesday, May 17, and Thursday, May 18, to remove message boards over the roadways, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation.

Northbound I-35 just north of the 18th Street Expressway interchange will have one lane reduced at 8 p.m. on May 17, then a second lane will be reduced at 11 p.m. At midnight, northbound I-35 will be fully closed to traffic for five minutes to finish removing the message board. I-35 will be open to normal traffic by 5 a.m.

Southbound I-35 just south of the Southwest Boulevard interchange will have one lane reduced at 8 p.m. on May 18. A second lane will be reduced at 11 p.m. and the southbound Southwest Boulevard ramp will be closed. At midnight, southbound I-35 will be fully closed to traffic for five minutes to finish removing the message board. The ramp will be re-opened after this, and I-35 will be open to normal traffic by 5 a.m.

Motorists are asked to use extra caution in the work zone area.
