## **Lane Reductions I-435 on October 28th**

The Kansas Department of Transportation will divert westbound I-435 east of U.S. 69 onto the U.S. 69 exit ramp. Traffic will be able to exit onto Quivira Road from this exit and continue back onto westbound I-435.

Starting at 7 a.m., westbound I-435 will be reduced in lanes and diverted onto the ramps.

The inside lane of eastbound I-435 will also be closed for 10 minutes to remove and replace the message board for this work. This closure will occur twice, once at approximately 7 a.m. and again at approximately 12 p.m.

Once the work has been completed, westbound I-435 will reopen and traffic will no longer be diverted onto the ramps.

Motorists should expect short delays when the closures are happening and for a brief time after they are completed.
