## **U.S. 69 night work at 132<sup>nd</sup> Street bridge to affect traffic**

Northbound U.S. 69 at the 132<sup>nd</sup> Street overpass bridge will be reduced to one lane at 8 p.m. on Thursday, May 4, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation. The lane reduction is necessary to install a new sign truss and message board over the roadway.

For five minutes somewhere between midnight and 4 a.m., northbound U.S. 69 will be fully closed to finish installing the message board. The work will be done and the highway opened to normal traffic by 5 a.m.

Similar schedules for message board updates will be followed, weather permitting, on May 10 on eastbound I-435 east of the Roe Avenue interchange and on May 11 on northbound I-35 north of the 18<sup>th</sup> Street Expressway interchange

Motorists are asked to use extra caution in the work zone area.
