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## **Night work will reduce lanes on I-35 project**

Night work on a concrete patching, milling and asphalt overlay repair project on I-35 will begin on Monday, May 6, weather permitting, from 95<sup>th</sup> Street south to 135<sup>th</sup> Street in Johnson County, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation.

Lane reductions will take place from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. throughout the project area. Some Sunday work may be necessary. Ramps will be closed intermittently for milling and overlay during the repair work, and there will be no signed detours. Motorists are urged to allow extra time to their travel schedule or use an alternate route.

The work is scheduled to be completed by late October. O'Donnell and Sons Construction Co. Inc., of Overland Park is the contractor on the \$10.8 million project.

Motorists are asked to use extra caution throughout the construction project.
