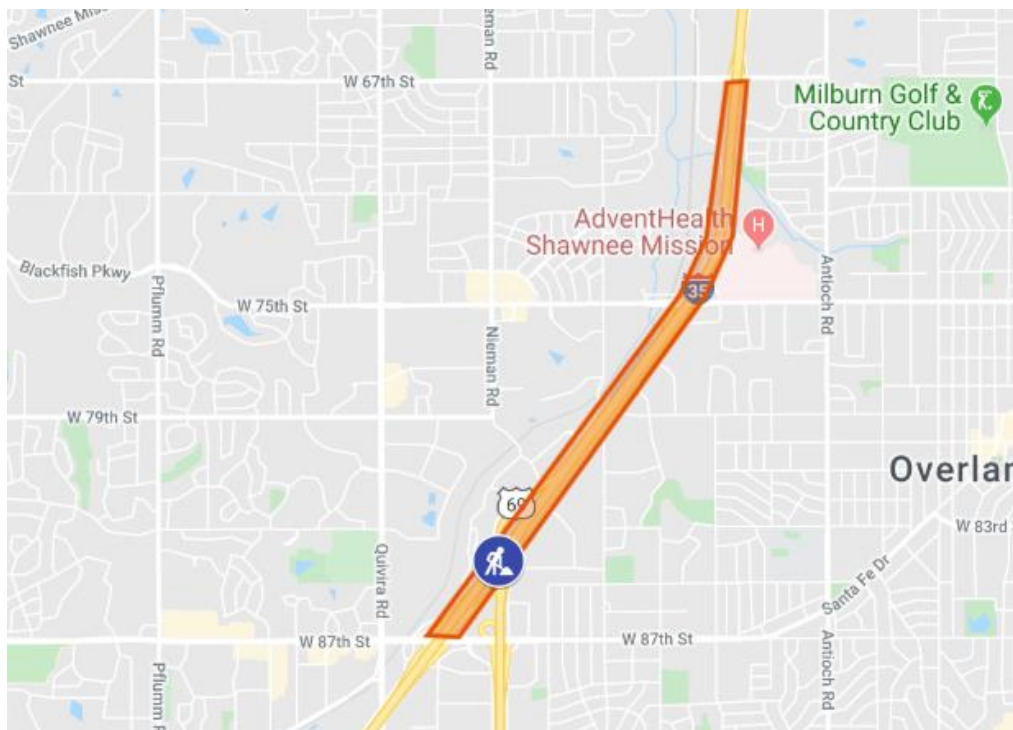

# Lane closures planned for southbound I-35 at U.S. 69 this Friday night

The Kansas Department of Transportation, as part of the U.S. 69 bridge project over I-35, will close the two left lanes of southbound I-35 from 67<sup>th</sup> Street to 87<sup>th</sup> Street from 8 p.m. Friday night (Oct. 25) to 6 a.m. Saturday morning (Oct. 26). The lanes are being closed to allow overhead work as concrete is placed on the U.S. 69 bridge over I-35.



Motorists are reminded to slow down and pay attention while driving in work zones.
