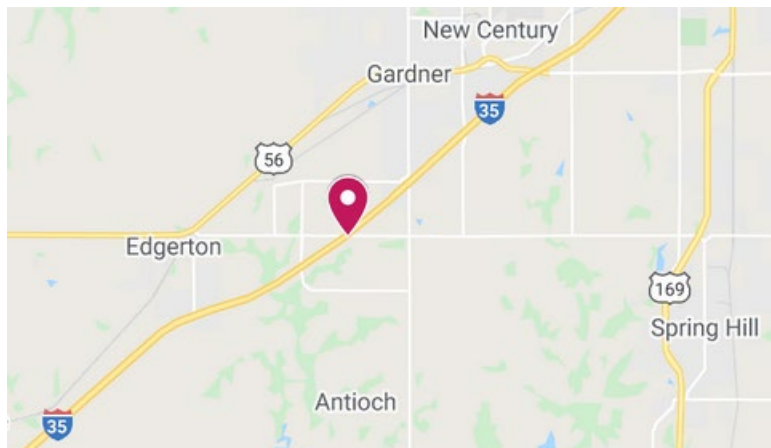
Lane closures on southbound I-35 in Johnson County April 17

Short-term lane closures are scheduled, weather permitting, to place girders over southbound I-35 at 199th Street on Saturday, April 17, into Sunday, April 18, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation.

Both southbound and northbound I-35 will have lane reductions starting at 8 p.m. on Saturday. Then beginning at 10 p.m., there will be rolling road closures on southbound I-35 for a maximum of 15 minutes from mile markers 205 to 207. I-35 traffic will return to the posted speed before the next 15-minute closure takes place. Work will finish by 8 a.m. Sunday.

Drivers should expect delays and are encouraged to find alternative routes. If there are winds higher than 20 mph or rainy conditions, the work will be rescheduled.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of all road construction projects across Kansas go to www.kandrive.org or call 5-1-1. Drive safely and always wear your seat belt.
