Section of southbound Turner Diagonal closed April 20

A portion of the southbound Turner Diagonal from 65th Street to K-32 in Wyandotte County will be closed to traffic on Tuesday, April 20, weather permitting, to allow for work to remove an overhead sign truss over the roadway.

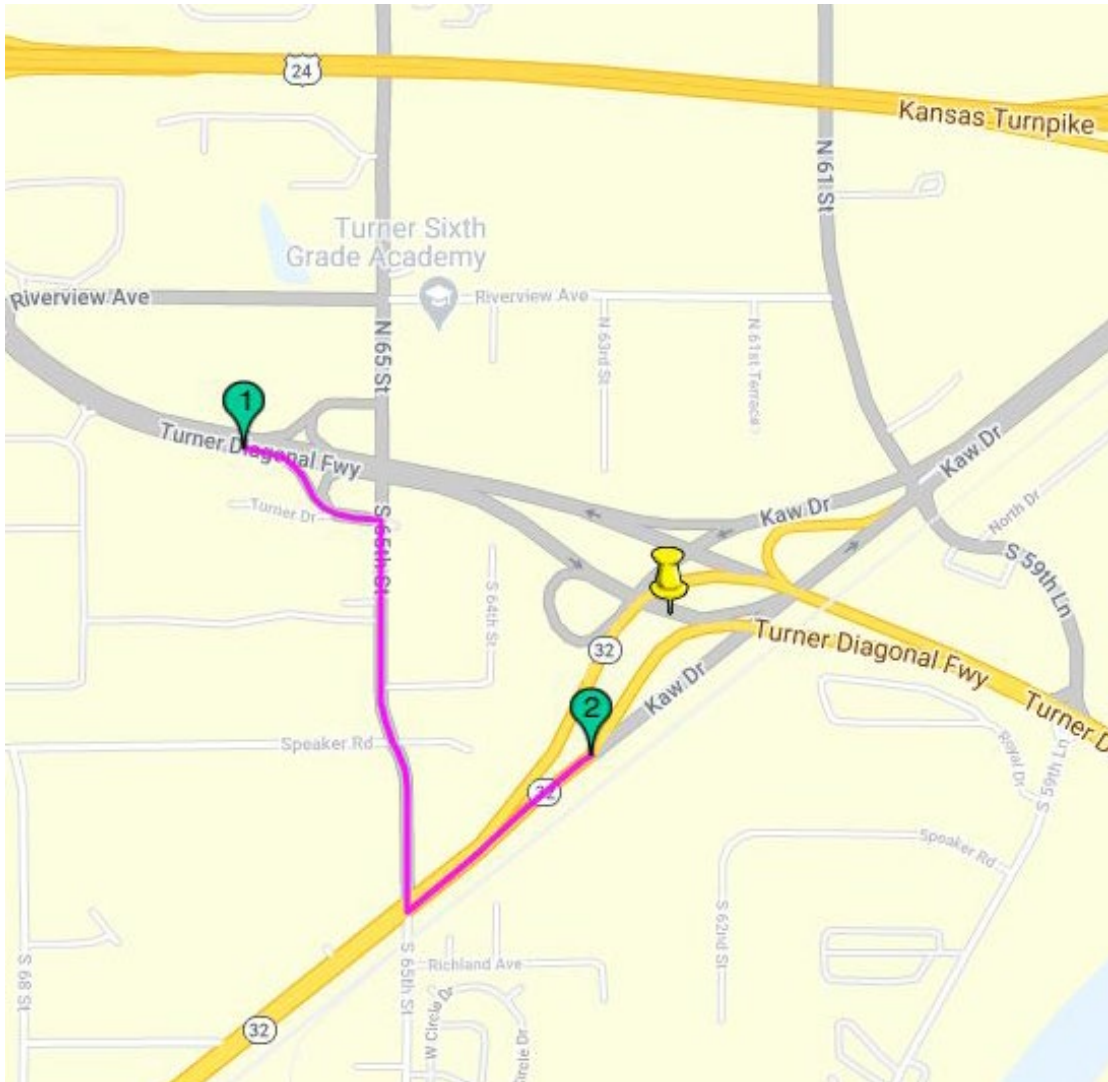
According to the Kansas Department of Transportation, work will take place from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Traffic can travel south on 65th Street and east on K-32 back to the Turner Diagonal. Motorists should use an alternate route or allow extra time in their travel schedule and expect delays.

If weather affects the sign removal, the work schedule will be postponed one day to Wednesday, April 21.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of all road construction projects across Kansas go to www.kandrive.org or call 5-1-1. Drive safely and always wear your seat belt.
