I-35 surface replacement work begins tonight in Johnson County

According to the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT), work on an I-35 asphalt mill and overlay project from I-635 to Lamar Avenue is scheduled to begin Aug. 24, weather permitting.

This northbound and southbound I-35 project will include ramps and chip seal shoulders, with nightly lane and ramp closures where necessary.

Traffic will be controlled using portable message signs, arrow boards, signage and traffic cones. Message boards alerting motorists are in place, notifying the start of the project.

Work will occur 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday through Saturday. The project is anticipated to be completed in mid-October.

Superior Bowen, of Kansas City, Mo., is the contractor for the \$1.2 million project.
