JOHNSON COUNTY

KDOT short-term closures:

NB and SB U.S. 169 at 199th St., December 4-23, **NEW**. No eastbound turns from U.S. 169 to 199th St. to expand eastbound turn lanes.

SB K-7 at College Blvd., December 9, **NEW**. WB College Blvd. left turn lane closed and **ramp closed** (College Blvd. to SB K-7 entrance ramp) for guardrail and edge drop-off repair from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

KDOT construction projects affecting traffic:

NB U.S. 69/179th St. to 191st St., start date June 14, **ONGOING**. **Bridge maintenance project**; NB U.S. 69 will be reduced to one lane for bridge maintenance (short-term intersections closures at 162nd St. and 175th St.). Work will occur 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, with work on Saturday as needed. Project completion expected by early December.

WYANDOTTE COUNTY

KDOT short-term closures:

I-70/Fairfax Tfwy.:

December 8, NEW. WB I-70 right lane closed and **ramp closed** (WB I-70 to Washington Blvd. exit ramp) for bridge inspections from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

December 9, NEW. **EB I-70 roadway closed** (James St. exit to Missouri state line) for bridge inspections from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. EB I-70 traffic will be diverted to James St. exit.

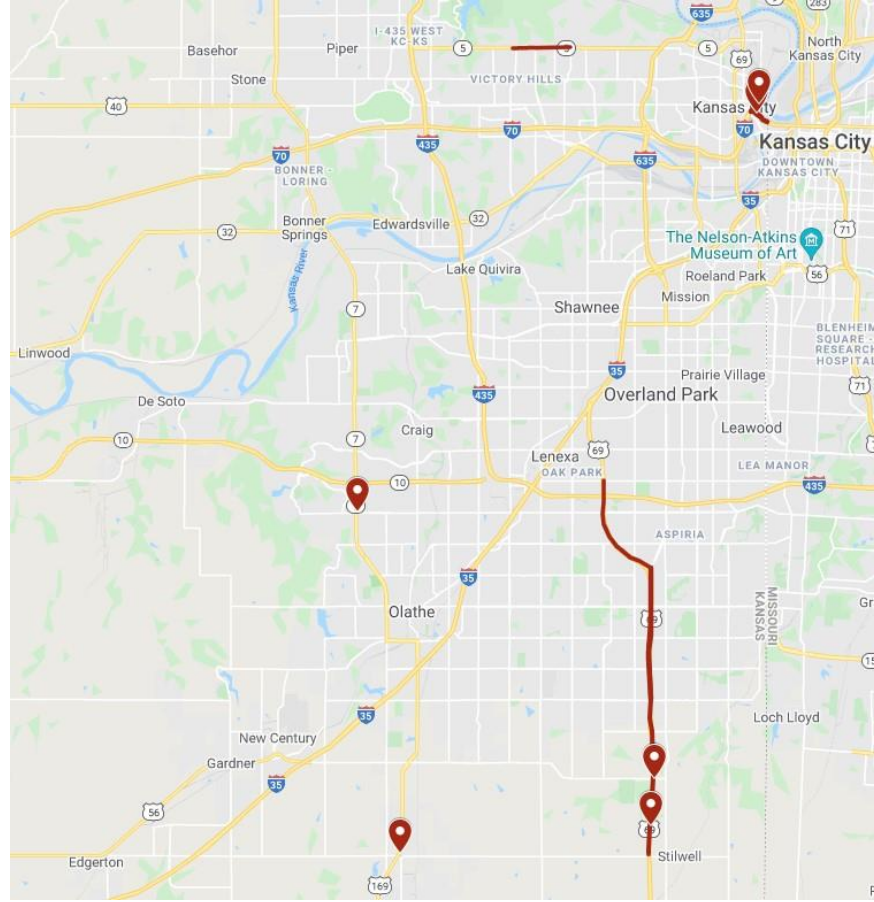
December 10, NEW. EB I-70 left lane closed and **ramp closed** (SB Fairfax Tfwy. to EB I-70 entrance ramp) for bridge inspections from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

KDOT construction projects affecting traffic:

Unified Government project. Leavenworth Rd./K-5 from 78th St. to 63rd St., start date February 15, **ONGOING**. **Roadway improvement project**; roadway reduced to one 11 ft. wide lane of thru traffic using flagging operation. Improvements include grading, surfacing and storm sewer work. Work will occur during daylight hours; project completion expected by mid-December.
