### JOHNSON COUNTY

*KDOT short-term closures:*

**NB I-435, 53<sup>rd</sup> St. to Woodend Rd., December 2, NEW – UPDATED.** Intermittent lane closures for bridge inspections from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

---

*KDOT construction projects affecting traffic:*

**NB U.S. 69/179<sup>th</sup> St. to 191<sup>st</sup> St., start date June 14, ONGOING. Bridge maintenance project;** NB U.S. 69 will be reduced to one lane for bridge maintenance (short-term intersections closures at 162<sup>nd</sup> St. and 175<sup>th</sup> St.). Work will occur 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, with work on Saturday as needed. Project completion expected by early December.

### WYANDOTTE COUNTY

*KDOT short-term closures:*

**I-70/Fairfax Tfwy., December 6, NEW. Ramp closed** (WB I-70 to Fairfax Tfwy. exit ramp) for bridge inspections from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.

**I-70/Fairfax Tfwy., December 7, NEW. Ramp closed** (SB Fairfax Tfwy. to EB I-70 entrance ramp) for bridge inspections from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

*KDOT construction projects affecting traffic:*

- 1. EB and WB I-70, 110<sup>th</sup> St. to I-435, start date August 23, ONGOING – UPDATED. Pavement improvement project;** lanes will be reduced, and ramps will be closed in areas where work is taking place. Work will occur Monday to Friday, with Saturdays as needed, from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Project completion expected by early December.
- 2. U.S. 169 (7<sup>th</sup> St.)/I-70, start date June 16, ONGOING – UPDATED. Bridge maintenance project;** WB I-70 to SB U.S. 169 (7<sup>th</sup> St.) exit ramp has reopened and U.S. 169 (7<sup>th</sup> St.) lane closures have ended. Underneath bridge, work is still active from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Friday, and Saturdays as needed. Project completion expected by early December.

3. **Unified Government project. Leavenworth Rd./K-5 from 78<sup>th</sup> St. to 63<sup>rd</sup> St.**, start date February 15, **ONGOING**. **Roadway improvement project**; roadway reduced to one 11 ft. wide lane of thru traffic using flagging operation. Improvements include grading, surfacing and storm sewer work. Work will occur during daylight hours; project completion expected by mid-December.

## **LEAVENWORTH COUNTY**

*KDOT construction project affecting traffic:*

**K-32 and 222nd St., west of Linwood**, start date April 5, **ONGOING – UPDATED**. **Intersection improvement project**; work includes grading and asphalt surfacing for new lanes. **Traffic will be carried through existing lanes for duration of project, using flagging and pilot car operation.**

Drivers should expect delays of up to 15 minutes and may want to find an alternative route. Work will occur 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday to Friday and Saturdays, as needed. Project completion expected by early December.

## **MULTI-COUNTY**

*KDOT construction projects affecting traffic:*

**Jefferson Co.: U.S. 59 approximately 3 miles north of U.S. 24; Johnson Co.: I-435 at Johnson Dr.; Leavenworth Co.: K-32 at Hemphill Rd.; Wyandotte Co.: K-5 near 18<sup>th</sup> St., I-435 north of Woodend Rd., I-435 at Wolcott Dr.**, start date August 9, **ONGOING – UPDATED**. **Stormwater pipe repair project**; lane and ramp closures as project progresses; work will take place during daylight hours. Work on I-435 in Wyandotte Co. and U.S. 59 in Jefferson Co. will be in the right-of-way and off the pavement; shoulder closures may be used in these locations. **Please see “Short-Term Closures” for applicable daily closure info.** Project completion expected by early December.
