I-35 pavement project in Johnson and Wyandotte counties to begin July 19

A pavement marking repair project on I-35 from 95th Street to the Missouri state line (approximately 11 miles) is scheduled to begin Monday, July 19, weather permitting.


According to the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT), this northbound and southbound I-35 will have nightly lane and ramp closures in areas where work is occurring. Message boards alerting motorists are in place, notifying the start of the project.

Work will occur 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday through Friday. The project is anticipated to be completed in late August.

Twin Traffic, of Kansas City, Mo., is the contractor for the \$1.2 million project.
