JOHNSON COUNTY

KDOT maintenance:

- For pothole patching, northbound and southbound I-35, alternating mobile lane closures, right two and left two lanes, I-435 to Cambridge Cr., from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Mon. Jan. 11 to Wed. Jan. 13. **NEW**
- For bridge repair, to pour concrete into the hub rails, ramp closures, eastbound K-10 to northbound K-7 and southbound K-7 to eastbound K-10, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Tues. Jan. 12. **NEW**



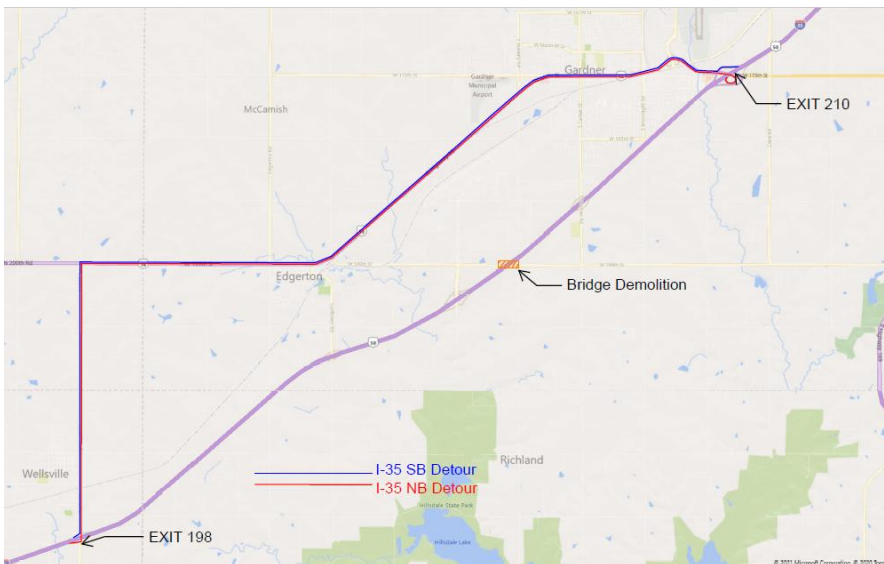
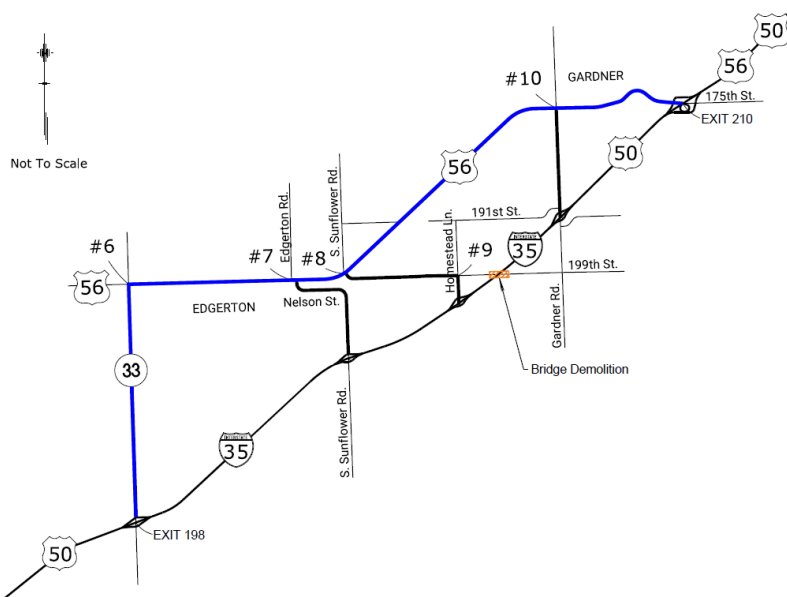
- For pothole patching, **intermittent left and right lane mobile closures, northbound and southbound I-435, Midland Drive to the Kansas River, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Wed. Jan. 13 & Thurs. Jan. 14. NEW**

KDOT construction projects affecting traffic:

- 1. Bridge demolition of the existing 199th St. bridge over I-35 – NEW**
Northbound and southbound I-35 will be shut down and traffic detoured from 5 a.m. Sat. Jan. 30 to 5 a.m. Sun. Jan. 31.

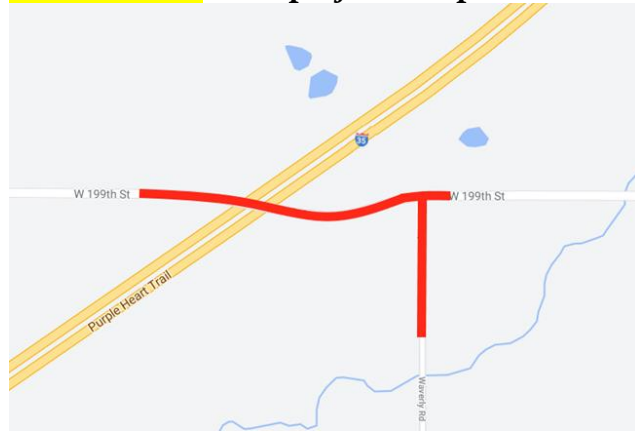
➤ Detour route:

- Southbound I-35 onto Exit 210/U.S. 56, then back to I-35 at Wellsville.
- Northbound I-35 onto Exit 198/K-33, then to U.S. 56 back to I-35 at Gardner.

- 2. 199th St and Waverly Road - (ONGOING)**

The 199th Street overpass over I-35 between Homestead Lane and Gardner Road is closed for the replacement of the overpass bridge. Waverly Road access to 199th Street from 207th Street is also closed. This project is expected to be completed by October 2021.



WYANDOTTE COUNTY

KDOT maintenance:

- For manhole repair, single left lane closure, northbound I-635 from 43rd St. to Georgia Ave., 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Tues. Jan. 12. **NEW**

KDOT construction projects affecting traffic:

1. U.S. 169/7th St./Herman Dillon bridge replacement project, installation of work platform, single daily lane closures, northbound U.S. 169/7th St. bridge over the Kansas River, from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m., Mon. Jan. 11 to Fri. Jan. 15. **NEW**
2. Reconfiguration of the Turner Diagonal interchange in Wyandotte County
A new diverging diamond interchange has been built, clean up and seeding is ongoing.
 - Eastbound and westbound I-70 truck staging areas are open.
 - New public restroom is closed due to clogged plumbing.
 - Northbound College Parkway/Turner Diagonal Freeway is open.
3. Lewis and Clark Viaduct bridge replacement
Westbound I-70 will be closed past Broadway Blvd (in Missouri NW corner of the downtown loop) to 3rd St in Kansas City, Kansas for bridge replacement.

NEW - Upcoming lane and ramp closures:

- For removal of temporary concrete safety barriers, temporary pavement markings, traffic control signage and placement of permanent pavement markings the following lane and ramp closures will occur intermittently, from 5 a.m. Sat. Jan. 16 to 5 a.m. Mon. Jan. 18, weather permitting.

➤ Westbound I-70 from the I-29/I-35/U.S. 71 jct. to the I-35/I-70 split.

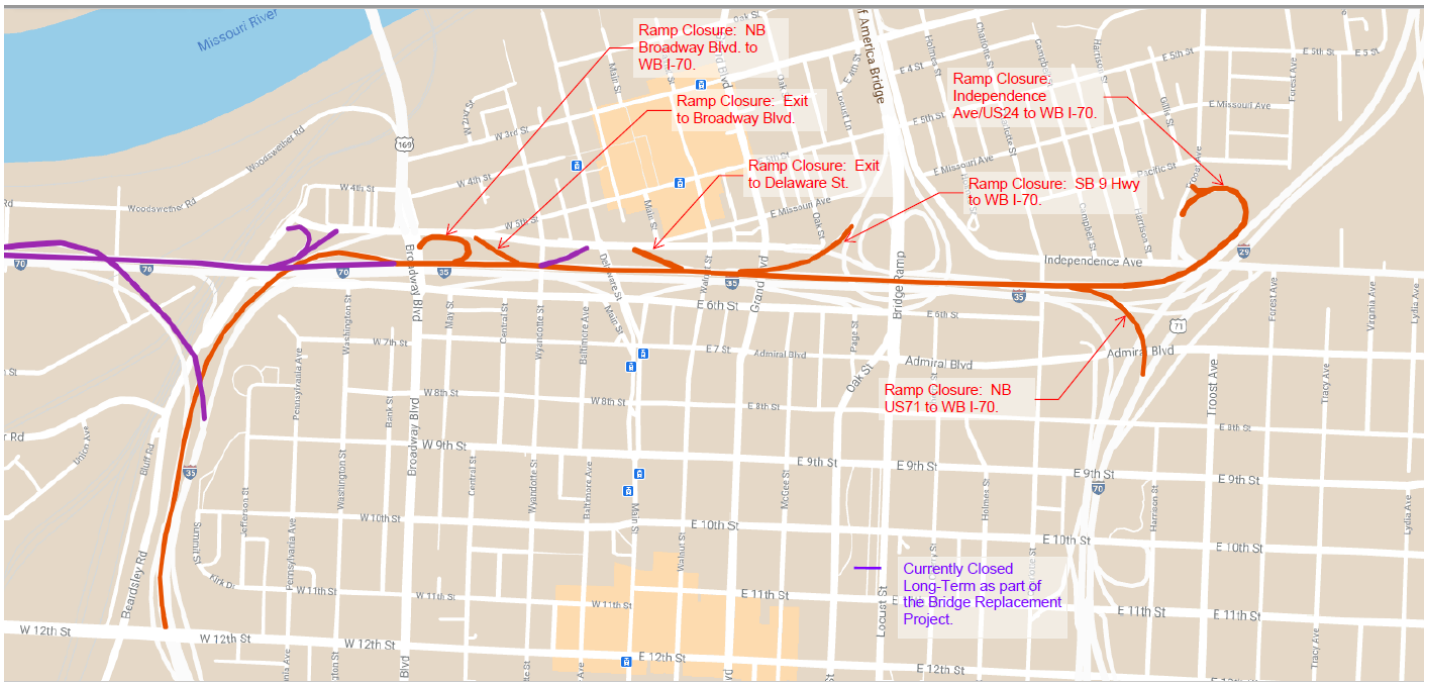
➤ In Missouri:

- Southbound I-35 ramp to westbound I-70,
- Northbound Broadway St. ramp to westbound I-70,

- Southbound 9 Hwy. ramp to westbound I-70,
- Independence Ave./24 Hwy. ramp to westbound I-70,
- Northbound 71 Hwy. ramp to westbound I-70.

(see map below, red are closures for 1/16-18, purple are current long-term closures)

- Ramps closed – **current, long-term closures**
 - Ramps from 5th St, Beardsley Rd, Independence Ave at Delaware Ave. and I-35 to Westbound I-70 (in Missouri) will be closed.
 - Ramps from Westbound I-70 to Minnesota Ave, Washington Blvd, and Fairfax Trafficway will be closed.

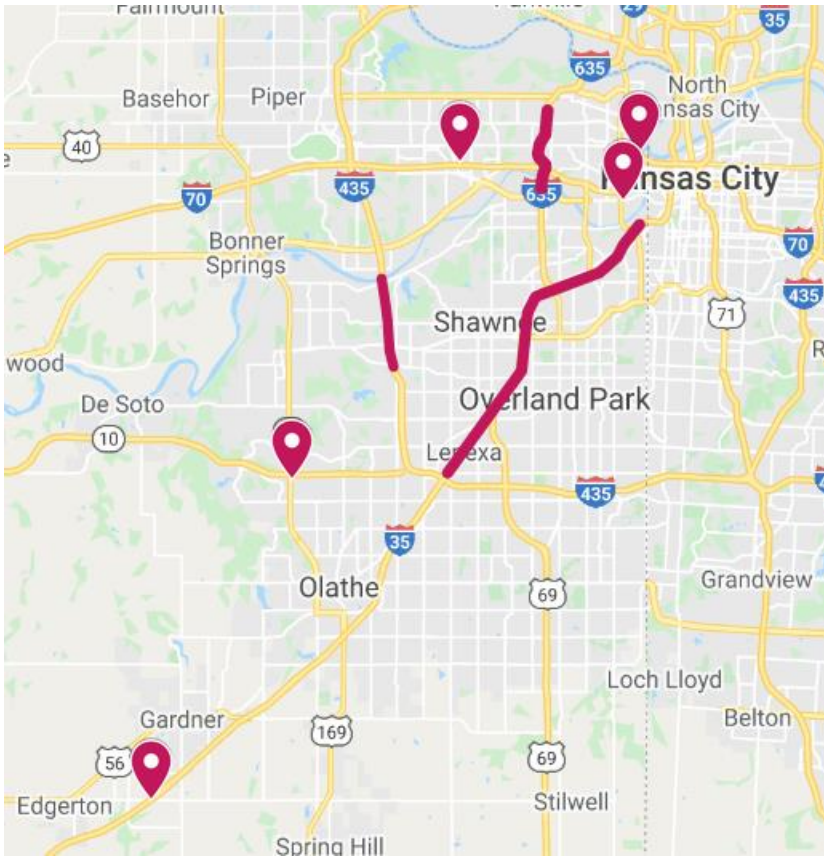
