PLEASE NOTE: I-70/Lewis and Clark Viaduct bridge repair project has been completed. <u>EB I-70 is</u> <u>fully reopened to traffic</u>, including downtown Kansas City, Kan. EB I-70 entrance ramps (Minnesota Ave./4th St., Washington Blvd. and Fairfax Tfwy.).

JOHNSON COUNTY

KDOT short-term closures:

NB and SB U.S. 69, 103rd St. to 179th St., November 1-30, NEW. Intermittent lane closures for geologic exploratory work from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

I-35 at 119th St., **November 11-19, NEW.** NB and SB I-35 reduced to one lane for bridge painting and concrete repairs, Monday- Saturday from 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m.

SB I-35, 151st St. to 167th St., November 16, NEW. Left two lanes closed for pavement patching and asphalt overlay from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

KDOT construction projects affecting traffic:

- 1. K-7 at Prairie Star Pkwy., start date September 20, NEW. Interchange improvement project; includes widening exit ramps to accommodate dedicated right and left turn lanes, adding traffic signals at ramp terminals and resurfacing Prairie Star Pkwy. Work will occur 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, with work on Saturday as needed. Project completion expected by late March 2022.
- SB I-35, 151st St. to 167th St., start date August 16, ONGOING. Pavement patching and asphalt overlay project; lane closures in areas where work is taking place. <u>Please see "Short-Term</u> <u>Closures" for applicable nightly closure info</u>. Work will occur from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. In spring 2022, paving work will resume on NB I-35. Project completion on SB I-35 expected by late November.
- **3.** NB U.S. 69/179th St. to 191st St., start date June 14, ONGOING. Bridge maintenance project; NB U.S. 69 will be reduced to one lane for bridge maintenance (short-term intersections closures at

162nd St. and 175th St.). Work will occur 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, with work on Saturday as needed. Project completion expected by mid-November.

- City of Olathe project. I-35/119th St. bridge, start date June 1, ONGOING UPDATED. Bridge improvement project; I-35 will have daily lane closures. Right turns onto 119th St. from I-35 and right turns onto I-35 from 119th St. will be allowed. <u>Please see "Short-Term Closures" for</u> <u>applicable daily I-35 closure info</u>. Project completion expected by late December.
- 5. K-10 at Lexington Ave., start date May 24, ONGOING UPDATED. Bridge reconstruction project; a crossover, or temporary asphalt road, will be constructed in the median to redirect traffic onto WB K-10. Once traffic is redirected, the EB K-10 bridge deck installation will begin. <u>EB and WB K-10, near Lexington Ave., will be reduced to one lane of traffic in each direction, and EB K-10 entrance ramp from Lexington Ave. will be closed</u>. Work will occur Monday through Friday during daylight hours, with work on Saturday as needed. Project completion expected by late November.
- 6. 199th St. overpass and Waverly Rd., NB and SB I-35, start date April 17, ONGOING UPDATED. Overpass bridge replacement project; 199th St. over I-35 closed between Homestead Ln. and Gardner Rd.; Waverly Rd. access to 199th St. from 207th St. also closed. <u>Please see "Short-Term Closures" for applicable daily closure info</u>. Project completion expected by early December.

WYANDOTTE COUNTY

KDOT short-term closures:

NB and SB K-5, I-435 to K-7, **November 5** – **25, NEW.** Single lane closures for boom mower operations from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

SB I-635, Missouri River to 34th St. bridge, November 16 – 29, NEW. Traffic reduced to single lane for pavement widening work from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.

EB I-70, 57th St. to I-635, **November 17, NEW.** Right two lanes closed for pothole repair from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

EB and WB I-70, I-435 to 110th St., **November 17 – 23, NEW.** Double lane closure and <u>short-term</u> <u>ramp closures</u> (SB I-435 at 110th St. entrance and exit ramps) for pavement marking from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

KDOT construction projects affecting traffic:

- NB and SB I-635/K-5 interchange, start date October 1, NEW. Bridge replacement project; single lane closures on I-635 and intermittent ramp closure (SB I-635 exit to SB K-5). Work will occur Monday to Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. <u>Please see "Short-Term Closures" for applicable daily closure info</u>. Project will be shut down for the winter from December 10 to March 12, 2022; completion expected in December 2022.
- 2. EB and WB I-70, 110th St. to I-435, start date August 23, ONGOING. Pavement improvement project; lanes will be reduced, and ramps will be closed in areas where work is taking place. Work will occur Monday to Friday, with Saturdays as needed, from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Project completion expected by mid-November.

- 3. U.S. 169 (7th St.)/1-70, start date June 16, ONGOING UPDATED. Bridge maintenance project; WB I-70 to SB U.S. 169 (7th St.) exit ramp has reponed and U.S. 169 (7th St.) lane closures have ended. Underneath bridge, work is still active from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Friday, and Saturdays as needed. Project completion expected by mid-November.
- 4. Unified Government project. Leavenworth Rd./K-5 from 78th St. to 63rd St., start date February 15, ONGOING. Roadway improvement project; roadway reduced to one 11 ft. wide lane of thru traffic using flagging operation. Improvements include grading, surfacing and storm sewer work. Work will occur during daylight hours; project completion expected by mid-December.

LEAVENWORTH COUNTY

KDOT construction project affecting traffic:

K-32 and 222nd St., west of Linwood, start date April 5, ONGOING. Intersection improvement project; work includes grading and asphalt surfacing for new lanes. <u>Traffic will be carried through existing lanes for duration of project, using flagging and pilot car operation.</u> Drivers should expect delays of up to 15 minutes and may want to find an alternative route. Work will occur 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday to Friday and Saturdays, as needed. Project completion expected by mid-November.



KDOT construction projects affecting traffic:

Jefferson Co.: U.S. 59 approximately 3 miles north of U.S. 24; Johnson Co.: I-435 at Johnson Dr.; Leavenworth Co.: K-32 at Hemphill Rd.; Wyandotte Co.; K-5 near 18th St., I-435 north of Woodend Rd., I-435 at Wolcott Dr., start date August 9, ONGOING. Stormwater pipe repair project; lane and ramp closures as project progresses; work will take place during daylight hours. Work on I-435 in Wyandotte Co. and U.S. 59 in Jefferson Co. will be in the right-of-way and off the pavement; shoulder closures may be used in these locations. <u>Please see "Short-Term Closures" for</u> <u>applicable daily closure info.</u> Project completion expected by mid-November.
