KDOT to provide U.S. 69 expansion updates at virtual public meeting, open house

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT), along with the Kansas Turnpike Authority (KTA) and the City of Overland Park, will host a live, virtual meeting from 5:30-7:30 p.m. Wednesday, Dec. 8, to update the public on the U.S. 69 Expansion project.

At the live, virtual meeting, project team members will discuss the U.S. 69 environmental assessment, summarize noise study results and review noise wall recommendations. In its analysis, KDOT used similar design criteria previously used on I-435 and U.S. 69 projects – along with updated traffic volumes and design information for U.S. 69's current and projected conditions.

In addition to the meeting, a virtual open house will be available for 30 days by following the link on www.69express.org beginning Dec. 8. The open house and the public meeting will provide the same content, and questions can be submitted on both webpages.
